# CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
3. BIDDING:
  - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale. Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again. The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.
  - 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
  - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
  - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

Under \$100 - \$5 increases	\$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases
\$100-\$300 - \$10 increases	\$5,000-\$10,000 - \$200 increases
\$300-\$500 - \$20 increases	\$10,000-\$20,000 - \$500 increases

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. **Live online bidding** is possible through Auction Mobility, through our website. An extra 3% charge applies to all successful Auction Mobility bids.

Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at seventy percent (70%) of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-
  - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
  - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
  - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and
  - 9.4 to proceed against the buyer for damages for breach of contract.
10. The Auctioneer reserves the right to refuse admission to any person to either viewing or the sale room, and the Auctioneer may refuse any bid.

## **Mowbray International Numismatic Auction #20**

### **Friday 25th & Saturday 26th May 2018**

Mowbray Collectables' next sale on 25 and 26 May 2018 will offer the largest sale of New Zealand banknotes in New Zealand yet – nearly 500 banknote lots, together with many New Zealand coins, tokens and medals, in 920 lots with estimates over \$380,000, drawn from the Ian Birdling collection. Ian is a builder, entrepreneur and long-time collector specialising in New Zealand coins, tokens and banknotes, especially early New Zealand trading banknotes, error items and private issues. Foreign material includes Chinese, Scottish, English, US and other banknotes with a small number of World coins and medals.

The banknotes include many rare opportunities, starting from the 1840s with shin plasters, such as the unique 5 Shillings signed by James Smith, issued in 1845 in Wellington and the Edward Dorset One Pound, Taranaki, one of two known. They move on through 85 trading bank note lots from all six major banks that survived until the end of the trading bank issues in 1934 and other banks that did not last the distance, such as the Colonial Bank, with examples from One Pound to Fifty Pounds proofs and specimens, a Bank of Auckland ten pounds colour trial of 1865 – 67 and unissued Otago Banking Company 1850's 10 shillings to Five Pounds. 1840's Cheques from the New Zealand Banking Company, Kororarika and the Union Bank of Australia, signed by Wakefield in Wellington, add further early colonial items.

Amongst banknotes are one of the finest Bank of New Zealand One Pound notes from the 1898 -1902 fifth issue, estimated at \$NZ 12,000 in VF and the Union Bank of Australia 5 Pounds of 1905 in gF, estimated at \$5000. The auction includes a National Bank of New Zealand 50 pounds proof of 1873, first issue in gEF, estimated at \$3200. Issued notes are well represented, including several dates of BNZ notes not listed in the authoritative 2017 Andrew Clifford book on New Zealand trading bank notes. With trading bank notes generally selling above estimate in the Mowbray 16 March 2018 sale, there is plenty of interest in this selection.

The nearly 300 Reserve Bank note lots include the key Lefeaux fifty pounds in an attractive overall "otherwise gF", estimated at \$15,000. Fifty Pound notes from the other major signatories are all available, including the scarce Fleming R 109691, with about ten known with prefixes prior to the more common late R 199 series. A strong range of NZ proof and specimen notes features.

122 New Zealand error notes are included, from spectacular butterfly and other printing folds to wet ink transfers and serial errors. Most are decimal but predecimals are included.

A rare Scottish note is from The Banking Company in Aberdeen, 1799, Five Shillings, estimated at \$NZ4500. While the grade rates as Good, very few of these are available. Other early English and Scottish provincial banknotes are included with 44 Scottish note lots as well as other World notes.

New Zealand high grade coins include the Waitangi Crown in near UNC grade, estimated at \$NZ7000, a proof pattern 1949 Crown and 1879 Joseph Moore pattern penny in AU, as well as scarcer Australasian nineteenth century trade tokens such as Wilson, Mears, the Lipman Levy Australian mule penny and World War II internment camp tokens. The auction features a wide range of New Zealand error coins, including 5-cent and 10-cent brockages as well as the rare 2011 no date ten cent Proof Set. World coins include early Chinese and Asian examples and a broad selection of Edward VIII fantasy crowns.






