# CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
3. BIDDING:
  - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.  
Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again.  
The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.
  - 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
  - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
  - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

Under \$100 - \$5 increases	\$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. **Live online bidding** is possible through Auction Mobility, through our website. An extra 3% charge applies to all successful Auction Mobility bids.  
Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-
  - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
  - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
  - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and

# International Numismatic Auction #24

## Friday 6th March 2020

The 595 lots feature important Estate collections. The collection of Gordon Webster, ex-Deputy General Manager of the Bank of New Zealand (BNZ), offers scarce gold coins and New Zealand trading banknotes. More material is offered from the Waikato collection of Brian Pike, especially in Spanish Dollars and World Crowns, and from Dr Ray Hargreaves of Dunedin. New collections this time include one of African banknotes and that of Ray Staal, Wanganui, who had wide interests.

The Colonial Bank of New Zealand One Pound of 1887, Lot 512 (Est NZ15,000), is one of possibly as few as four of the type held privately, grading gF. The Colonial Bank was absorbed into the BNZ in 1895 after disastrous losses, including on loans to the Colonial Treasurer, J G Ward and William Larnach, builder of Larnach's Castle.

Other scarce New Zealand notes are a BNZ £10 of 1 October 1921 in F, Lot 513, estimated at \$6000; a Fleming £50 with early serial number R146298 in EF, Lot 534 (Est \$7000), a BNZ emergency issue 10 Shillings of 1 August 1916, date-stamped with no printers imprint in aF, Lot 521 (Est \$2400), and other BNZ notes, mostly in the F to VF range. All Reserve Bank Governors except Lefeaux are covered by the five £50 notes. Same number sets date back to the early Hardie, Russell and Brash issues.

World Banknotes include UNC ranges from Zambia, Malawi and Zimbabwe, tracing the havoc of the notorious Zimbabwe inflation through to ZA replacement Zimbabwe Hundred Trillion Dollars.

Over 140 gold lots include a rare George IV Half Sovereign of 1821, S3802, Lot 201, with ornately garnished shields in aEF (Est \$4000). Lots 204 and 205 allow comparison of different William IV Half Sovereign sizes, being 1834 (17.9mm in VF/gF, Est \$600) and 1836 (19.4mm in VF, Est \$1000), hard to find in higher grades. An 1887 5 Pounds in gEF (Est \$3500) and both the George VI 1937 plain edge proof Sovereign (Est \$4000) and Half Sovereign (Est \$1000) offer rare opportunities. The best medal is a superb medal by A Loewental for the death of Winston Churchill, depicting a hand holding a torch, issued by B A Seaby, 50 mm with 3.57 oz's of gold, UNC (Lot 397, Est \$9000).

Interesting New Zealand coins include the Joseph Moore 1879 pattern penny in nearly UNC grade (Lot 296, Est \$5000), higher grade and scarcer tokens and a very rare proof 1964 Threepence (Lot 332, Est \$1800). Superb fully uncirculated 1947 and 1948 Sixpences estimate at \$200 (Lots 330 & 331). A scarce pair of medals issued for the Traffic Enforcement Service before its absorption by the Police estimates at \$700 (Lot 417). Medals include interesting larger collections and British Sudan and New Zealand Military Medals.

World gold coins include the full set of 13 World Wildlife Fund 25th Anniversary gold coins of 1986 – 88, (Lot 169, Est \$12,000), with the China Wild Yak 100 yuan of 1986. Silver Crown sized coins include the scarce China “Birds over Junk” 1932 Dollar, UNC with some light green (Lot 28, Est \$2500) and a China Chihli Dollar of Year 24 (1898), kmY65.2 in EF (Lot 23, Est \$2000). From South America are the Peru Royalist 8 Reales 1824 JP, km130, with crowned 1824 counter stamped on a host Peru 8 Reale, with some green but AU (Lot 78, Est \$2000) and a Cuba Revolutionary Peso of 1872 – 77 with thin key counterstamp, PCGS EF40, (Lot 40, Est \$1500). Popular bulk world lots and many other single coins make this an auction for all collectors.

Ancient coins feature such figures as Julius Caesar, Augustus, Tiberias, Brutus, Cleopatra VII of Egypt and Judaeon figures such as Herod Agrippa, Felix & Porcius Festus and Judaeon Widow’s mites.

Gold related items include watches, chains, New Zealand gold nuggets, ingots and sovereign cases. An unusual offering includes numismatic artwork of James Berry relating to Australian, New Zealand, Island and US designs in Lots 426 to 432.

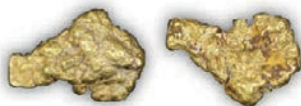

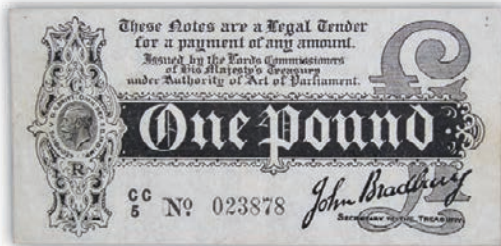

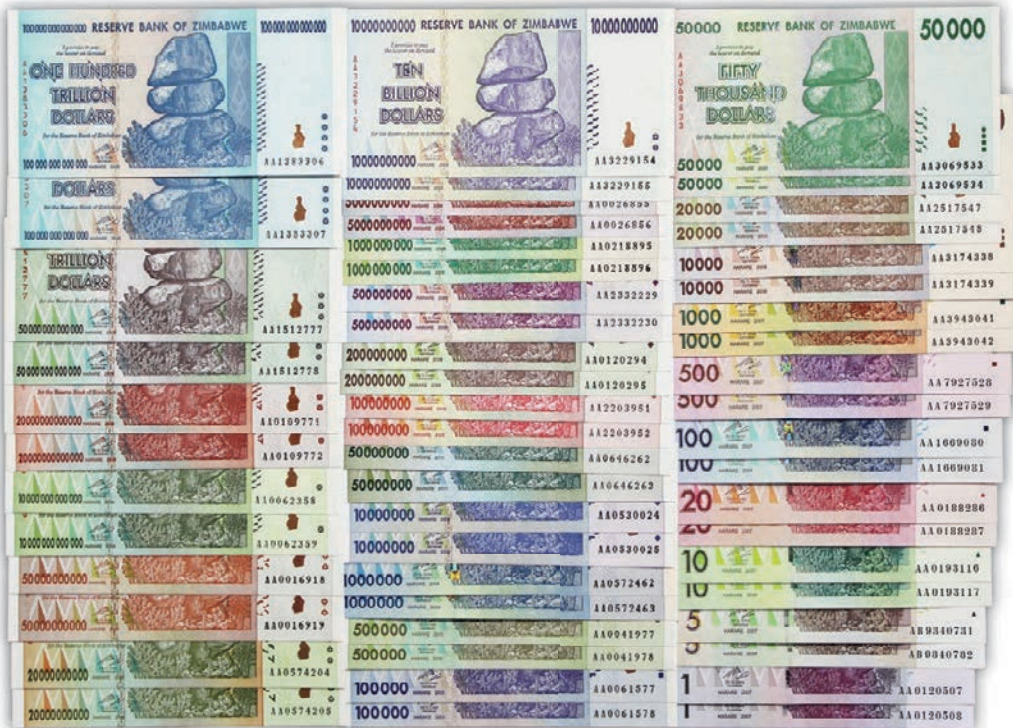
