

- INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
- 2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding seventy dollars (\$70).

#### 3. BIDDING

3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale. Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to whó is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again. The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his

3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the

Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.

3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.

3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.

4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Postal bids must comply with the following steps: Under \$300 - \$10 increases \$1,000-\$2,000 - \$50 increases \$300-\$500 - \$20 increases \$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases \$500-\$1,000 - \$25 increases

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.

5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in

the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.

- 6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at seventy percent (70%) of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
- 7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest.
- 8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
- FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-

9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the

Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited:

9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;

- 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and

## Mowbray International Numismatic Auction #18 13th October 2017

Welcome to Mowbray Collectables 18th International Numismatic auction and our second for 2017, with 552 lots totalling \$328,605 in estimates, catering for a wide range of collectors, dealers and numismatists.

World coins feature large collections, some extensively described in multiple albums. Unusual opportunities include collections from Portugal and the Azores, horse themed coins and the nineteenth century, early and unusual Maria Theresia Thalers, higher grade Fiji predecimal and always popular accumulations.

Another unusual opportunity is Judaean coins from a biblical collection, including from famous historical figures such as Herod the Great, Herod Archelaus who reigned at the time of Jesus birth, Pontius Pilate, Festus who sent St Paul to Rome after his appeal to Caesar and coins from Jewish rebellions. A Tyre shekel is of the type paid to Judas Iscariot as part of his "30 pieces of silver".

Ancient coins total 45, including British Celtic gold staters from the Iceni and Dumnocoveros Tigirseno. Some lots are very affordable with bronze and silver from Greece and Rome. High quality gold features Hadrian and Nero aurei, an Alexander the Great stater and others from Carthage, Kyrenaica (Cyrene) and Thrace, where Brutus, Caesar's assassin, held sway after Caesar's death.

Modern gold offers a great range of New Zealand gold including the sought after 2004 Pukaki Ten Dollar coin and scarce Aslan gold coin, Australian and British gold and an interesting range of World gold. US gold is especially strong, from an EF 1851 \$1 to Liberty Head double eagles and modern \$50 coins. Rarities include a large Proof Egyptian 500 piastres of 1932 and a Moroccan 500 dirhams of 1954 in UNC.

Thirty New Zealand token lots include an attractive New Zealand pattern penny in EF, scarcer tokens such as an Edward Reece Half penny and 18 Communion token lots, including rare tokens such as St John's Wellington, Otahuhu and Chalmers Church.

New Zealand coins offer a Waitangi Crown, higher grade predecimals including 1936 florins and important error coins, such as a penny on a sixpence blank, the Solomon Islands Mule \$5 of 2000 and a full 50 cent reverse brockage.

Interesting commemorative medals include a large 57mm, 4.08 oz gold medal for the death of Sir Winston Churchill by Edward Jones and a small Israeli gold group for events such as the Bar Mitzvah. Many New Zealand commemoratives are included in larger lots. The military medals include New Zealand Wars medals, and British Baltic, Egypt, India, King's and Queen's South Africa medals, while militaria features a rare SS Emden 200 pfennig canteen token.

The 36 World banknote lots feature extensive accumulations from all over the globe.

Attractive Hanna and Wilson 50 pounds lead the Reserve Bank of New Zealand banknotes. Trading banknotes include one of the three BNZ Ten Pound specimen uniform pairs thought to be held privately. Errors again feature with a Brash \$20 with the Queen's image shifted downwards and a Bollard \$5 without numbers.

Thanks are due to all who have contributed to this catalogue and sale. We particularly thank our vendors whose strong support continues and our many buyers. Our staff again have pulled out every stop to produce another great auction with the key contributors being Nicola Bowden, Jared Thornton, Rodney Hall, Maree Malin, Keren Malin, Jan McDonald, Paul Stark and John Mowbray.
