CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1 INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
- 2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
- 3. BIDDING:
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale. Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again. The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.
 - 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
 - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
- 4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at	the Auctioneer's discretion.

- 5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. Live online bidding is possible through Auction Mobility, through our website. An extra 3% charge applies to all successful Auction Mobility bids. Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.
- 6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
- 7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest.
- 8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
- 9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-
 - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited:
 - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
 - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and

International Numismatic Auction #23 Friday 20th September 2019

Outstanding features of the 776 lots with total estimates of \$NZ334,000 in Mowbray's 23rd auction are the ranges of World, British and gold coins and historical medals, many from the collection of Bryan Pike, an important Waikato collector. There are scarce New Zealand items too such as the 1949 Proof penny, and good ranges of New Zealand same number banknotes sets, including Reserve Bank Staff only issues, and higher-grade World banknotes.

Mowbrays strongest USA coins offering yet has 48 lots. Colonial Hibernia and Rosa Americana coins include a 1723 Penny, km10, in gEF, estimated at \$NZ1000. Commemorative 50 cents from

1918 to 1952, include the scarce 1921 Missouri 50 Cent, km149.1, estimated at \$600 in AU. A commemorative dollar of 1900, with

Washington and Lafayette, estimates at \$1000 in AU. Ten US gold Dollars to Double Eagle are offered.

The many silver Crown sized coins include the Australian Swan Dollar of 1967, nicely toned in UNC (est \$1200), the Hawaii Dollar of 1883, in gVF, est \$600 and Hong Kong 1867 Dollar, VF, est \$600. Bulk lots with many coins make this an auction for all collectors.

There are 20 early Spanish dollars, from a 1678 cob Potosi mint 8 reales in F, \$280 estimate, through to better struck milled coins from 1749 to 1821 as Spain lost its South American colonies. It doesn't stop there – 23 later Mexican official and revolutionary lots show the product of rich silver mines. Spain itself is represented by 11 lots including 4 gold coins. All up there are 63 World gold lots, such as the infrequently seen Dominican Republic 30 Pesos 1955 (est \$1800, EF) and Saudi Arabia 1947 Sovereign struck at Philadelphia for oil payments (est \$3000, AU).

The 103 British coins lots offer 24 maundy sets from Charles II to Elizabeth II, and almost all monarchs in between. Other features are the Ireland Charles I 1643 Ormonde civil war shilling, s6546, est \$600 in VF; George II young bust Crown of 1739, VF, est \$1000; and emergency issues of 1797 to 1804, with oval and octagonal counterstamps, the best an oval counterstamped British dollar on a scarce Potosi 1793 8 reales host coin in aEF, est \$1000. British gold ranges from a George II 1735 guinea in gF, est \$800, to Elizabeth II Gold Sovereign Proof Sets with full Half Sovereign to Five Pounds sets of 1980 and 1985, both estimated at \$4400.

Military Medals include 37 lots, mainly British, from the 1849 Punjab pattern medal to the 1930's, two specimen New Zealand Medals from the 1860's, estimated at \$300 each and a New Zealand Queen's South Africa award. Perhaps the most interesting is the British General Service Medal, 1918 - 30 with Iraq clasp, est \$600. Frank Riley, to whom it was awarded, was the son of the Archbishop of Perth, WA, a Captain in World War I, and a Journalist thought killed by the troops of Chiang Kai Shek in China in 1927.

Amongst 89 commemorative and other medals are many British and French Historical medals, predominantly from the seventeenth to the nineteenth centuries and Mowbrays' finest ever offering in this class. They are topped by the series of 40 Bronze 41 mm medals by famed medallist Mudie, commemorating British military and naval victories from the Napoleonic war period, issued in the 1820's. In superb condition, they estimate at \$7000. Napoleon has his say too with a Droz & Denon medal for the ill-fated planned invasion of England, showing his laureated bust and Hercules wrestling with a lion. A Pingo Bronze Cook medal of 1784, is estimated at \$1000 in AU. Sponsored by the Royal Society to mark the death of Captain James Cook in 1779, it is highly relevant to this 250th anniversary year of his discovery of New Zealand. A further Pingo medal marks the 1760 accession of George III (Eimer 683), est \$300, and another in silver by Briot, F, marks the Scottish coronation of Charles I in 1633, also est \$300.

A banknote highlight is a large offering of high grade, largely UNC modern world banknote issues from the collection of Dr Ray Hargreaves, prominent NZ numismatic author.

New Zealand banknote lots include 4 trading bank notes, including a Bank of Australasia 5 February 1926 5 pounds estimated at \$3200 in F, a CBA Ten Shillings in VG estimated at \$1400 and a good range of Reserve Bank issues, up to a Wilson 50 pounds in F, est \$1400. Decimals include a near full range of same number decimal sets from 1999 on, including the Reserve Bank staff only Wheeler 2015/16 issue, estimated at \$1000 and scarce "Noteworthy" same number set of 10 notes from the 1989 – 1993 period, est \$1400.

The very rare New Zealand 1949 Penny Proof, estimated at \$2300, is offered for the first time by Mowbrays. Also from New Zealand are a Morris Marks Penny estimated at \$400 in gVF, 1950's sets of UNC coins, not often found in high grades and 15 gold lots.
