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CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
3. BIDDING:
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.
Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again.
The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.
 - 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
 - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
 - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

Under \$200 - \$10 increases	\$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases
\$200-\$500 - \$20 increases	\$5,000-\$10,000 - \$200 increases
\$500-\$1,000 - \$25 increases	\$10,000-\$20,000 - \$500 increases
\$1,000-\$2,000 - \$50 increases	\$20,000 and above - \$1,000 increases

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. **Live online bidding** is possible through Auction Mobility, through our website. An extra 3% charge applies to all successful Auction Mobility bids.
Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 1.5% penalty interest per month from auction date.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-
 - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
 - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
 - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and
 - 9.4 to proceed against the buyer for damages for breach of contract.

International Numismatic Auction #28

Friday 18th March 2022 - 12.30pm

Our 18 March 2022 numismatic auction in Wellington offers 585 lots estimated at \$422,635.

The auction will be held at the West Plaza Hotel in accordance with our current Covid policies and Government regulations. The full catalogue is online with every lot illustrated.

The catalogue is diverse. Strengths are in high grade British coins, rare New Zealand patterns, military medals and badges and world coins from outstanding old collections.

Top billing goes to the rare South Africa 1939 Proof Set, Farthing to Half Crown, Lot 239 (Est \$16,000), one of just 30. The Shilling and Sixpence are found only in the sets.

British coins (93 lots) feature strongly from three 1960's collectors who sought high grade items long before their peers. They include include an 1826 proof Halfcrown (Lot 374, Est \$5000).

Rare pattern 1980's New Zealand coins feature in 10 lots. They include a 1983 pattern proof set with the early dollar design missing foliage on the twenty cent (Lot 489, Est \$5000), and 1986 twenty cent coins with the James Berry effigy of the Queen in Proof and AU (Lots 487 & 488, Est's \$2500 & \$2000). There are also interesting error and higher grade predecimal coins.

Banknotes include the 50 Pounds of Fleming and Wilson and the rare second prefix, first Lefeaux 1934 pound, serial 1A 000001, (Lot 541, Est \$7000), saved when paid for an Alexandra Hotel room in 1935. Major trading banks' notes are well represented. One of two possible examples is the Fleming solid number \$100, G222222, in aEF, (Lot 552, Est \$1600), and probably unique.

The best world banknote is the Tahiti Banque de l'Indochine 20 francs of 18 March 1914, F, an unlisted date but rare in any case (Lot 530, Est \$5000). World accumulations are worth inspection.

Gold coin lots number 83. A 1938 Fire Brigade gold fob medal (Lot 170, Est \$600), awarded to former Timaru Mayor J Hole, is shaped as a fireman's helmet and crossed axes.

A love token (Lot 460, Est \$2500) of Charles Quinn (aged 20), sentenced to life in Van Diemen's land at the Warwickshire Assizes in 1843 and Mary Kiveren (?), 19, shows pictorial maritime engraving.

Military medal lots number 77 and badge lots 78. The medals include an Air Force Cross (Lot 35 Est \$1800), a DFC (Lot 26, Est \$1800) and a Military Medal (Lot 17, Est \$1400) to Cpl Ola Gordon Richter, who became the signatory for 1920's BNZ £100 notes. New Zealand and British badges offer bulk lots from a superb collection such as scarce early helmet badges of the 3rd Battalion Wellington East Coast Rifle Volunteers, Thames Scottish Volunteers and Waimea Rifles (Est's \$700 - \$800).

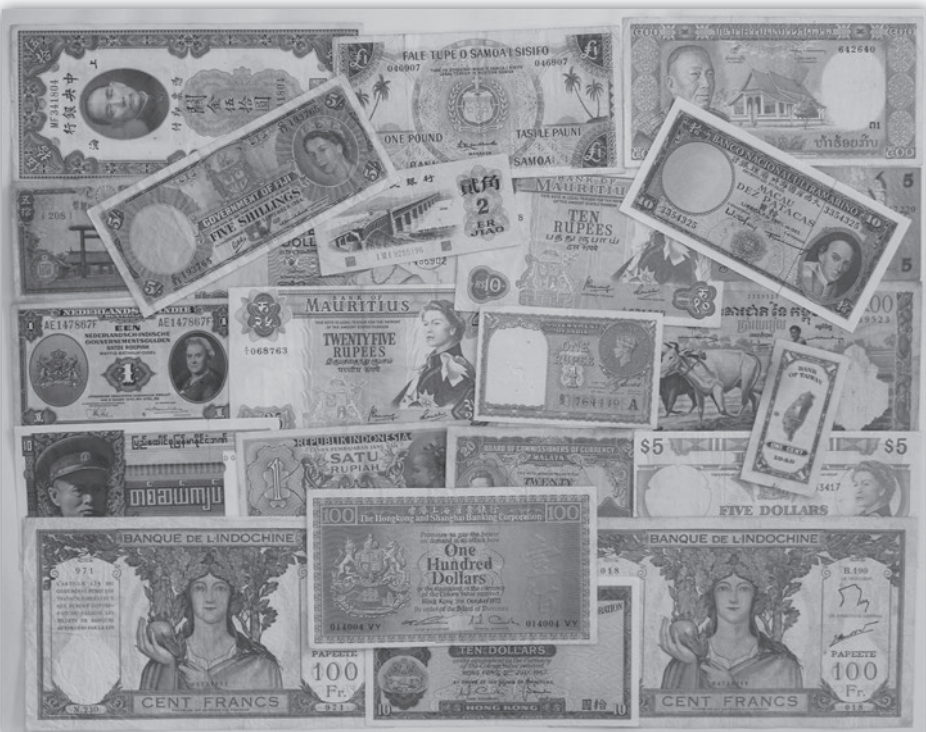

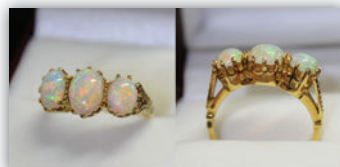

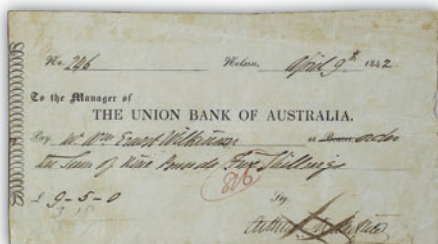
