CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1 INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
- 2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
- BIDDING:
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.

 Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again.

The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.

- 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding they have given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
- 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
- 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.

4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

- 6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
- 7. International Numismatic Auction #30 Friday 24th March 2023 - 12 noon

Welcome to our 30th International Numismatic Auction, with 600 lots and total estimates of \$477,000. Almost all have 70% reserves. All are illustrated online, many with more detailed photos than included in the printed catalogue. We also have links to additional research on medals and very high-resolution photos.

Interesting offerings include ancient gold and silver coins back to the first century of Western coinage issues 2500 years ago, military medals and badges from the early 1800's onwards, an Australian convict love token, the world's first sale of Euro notes to an EU citizen at introduction, which happened in New Zealand (Lot 495, Est \$800), the first NZ Government Pound notes intended as currency in 1894, produced as postal notes, such as the Pound (Lot 127, Est \$2000) and philatelic medals from the Gerald Ellott collection (Lots 91 – 99).

Top banknote is an issued Colonial Bank of New Zealand Pound of 1887, Lot 504 signed by Thomas J McKerrow, estimated to hammer at NZ15,000 in gF, with a pastoral life vignette, consigned by a reluctant seller. It last sold in Mowbray Auction 24 for \$14,500, plus 17% buyer premium. Alistair Robb recorded just two of this type in private hands. McKerrow started as a banker on the Otago goldfields and ended his career as a successful Dunedin stockbroker despite the infamous failure of the Colonial Bank, partly brought down by Joseph Ward, the heavily indebted Colonial Treasurer.

Thirteen Trading Bank notes also include Lot 505, an issued Bank of New Zealand Pound of 1903 with the classic shepherdess design, VF, Est \$12,000, with just five of the type listed by Pepping, and a large BNZ Ten Pounds of 1 October 1921, Lot 508, Est \$6000, with three of the type listed by Pepping in private hands, in F. The 101 Reserve Bank banknote lots include two Fifty Pound notes in Lots 526 and 544, Hanna (gVF, Est \$3500) and Fleming (AU, Est \$5000).

Two 1935 Waitangi Crowns, Lots 401 & 402, estimate at \$7000 and \$5500. Several orders of magnitude rarer still is the 1983 FDC Decimal Proof Set, (Lot 463, Est \$4000), with the pattern dollar missing the foliage in the Twenty Cents shown in the 25th anniversary of decimal coinage design, a major design blunder that was ultimately remedied in the common issued Dollar coin.

The 144 gold coins in the auction include Great Britain (Lots 305 – 338), James I Unite of 1604/5 in aVF; Queens Beasts 100 Pounds 2021, each estimated at \$3000, and a George VI 1937 Sovereign, PCGS Proof 65 Cameo, Est \$6500. World gold encompasses classic US coins, more modern bullion coins, scarce Chinese gold and a Roman aureus of Nero. Nineteen of the sixty-three world coin lots are ancient, some representing Augustus, Nero and Pontius Pilate.

Medal lots total 78, 47 being military, while other militaria and badge lots number 46. Highlights are a Military General Service Medal for the Napoleonic Wars to John Warner, with 8 clasps, Est \$1200, and a New Zealand Cross replica at \$2000 Est. Unusual items include elaborately carved walking sticks carved by Japanese POWs at the Featherston internment camp during WWII.

Thanks again go to our team who have striven to make a successful auction for our vendors and buyers – numismatists Liam Jennings, Michail Andreef and Ken Matthews, medal researcher Margaret Galt and auction organisers Maree Malin, Keren Malin, Kirsten Fulford, Jan Macdonald and John Mowbray.

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


