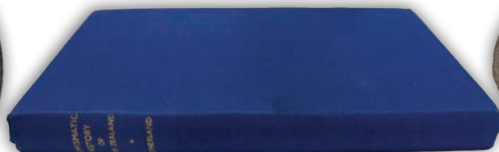
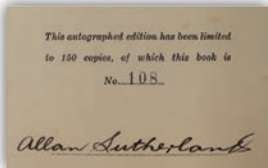

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
3. BIDDING:
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.
Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again.
The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at their discretion.
 - 3.2 Bidders shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding they have given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
 - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
 - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

Under \$250 - \$10 increases	\$5,000-\$10,000 - \$250 increases
\$250-\$1,000 - \$25 increases	\$10,000-\$20,000 - \$500 increases
\$1,000-\$2,000 - \$50 increases	\$20,000 and above - \$1,000 increases
\$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases	

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. **Live online bidding** is possible through Auction Mobility, through our website. An extra 3% charge applies to all successful Auction Mobility bids. Bids prior to the auction may be placed through our website, Auction Mobility or directly with us.
Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within seven days of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest per month from auction date.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-
 - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
 - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
 - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and
 - 9.4 to proceed against the buyer for damages for breach of contract.

International Numismatic Auction #32

Tuesday 19th March 2024 - 12 noon

Welcome to Mowbray Collectables 19 March 2024 auction with 589 lots totalling \$480,000. From affordable collections to over 100 gold items and rarities, there is something for everyone. Strong offerings are in banknotes, high grade and error NZ coins, ancient coins, world collections, English hammered, military medals and a fascinating group from the collection of Allan Sutherland, the renowned father of NZ numismatics, from lot 116 onwards.

The unique City Bank of Sydney issued Pound note of 1864, lot 445, is an important Australasian find, annotated with its provenance by Sydney wine and spirit merchant, Charles Thorn and later by Nathan/Joseph family members from the founding dynasty of the Glaxo Company that became British pharmaceutical giant GSK. It estimates at NZ\$12,500 in aF.

Top New Zealand banknote of the 89 lots offered is the 1934 Lefeaux 50 Pounds in aF, lot 523, Est \$20,000, the first offered by us since 2018. Other 50 Pounds include Hanna in gF at \$3500, and Fleming in EF at \$4500. Scarce Wilks Star \$1s, prefixes OA and OB at \$1000 each add interest.

The mix of 22 trading bank notes includes a National Bank Ten Shillings of 1 March 1920, lot 515 aF, Est \$5000, last offered in 2005 and BNZ 10 Pounds of 1 October 1928, gVF, at \$3500. The 56 World Banknote lots include 14 Chinese note lots, more from an old Shanghai collection developed from the 1920's, including a Ta-Ching Government Bank One Dollar, 1st June 1907, PMG equal finest known at AU 55 EPQ, Est \$5000. Good accumulations include Fiji, Malaya, the Straits Settlements, Scotland and a US Gold certificate trio of \$50, \$20 & \$10 (Est \$750).

The sorts of errors wanted in a catalogue include six NZ error banknotes and twenty NZ error coin lots, such as a Solomon Island 2000 mule set, lot 413, and splendid brockages. The 29 ancient coins include two large Egyptian gold coins, a 17.87g Pentadrachm, ca 285 - 246 BC of Ptolemy II, lot 287, Est \$18,000 in EF and a 27.74g Oktadrachm, lot 288, Est \$14,000, showing Arsinoe II, Ptolemy's wife, in gVF. Byzantine gold, and classic silver imagery in Athens' Owl, Corinth's Pegasos and a Julius Caesar Denarius of 47/46 BC add design and character.

Rare Chinese coins include a Yunnan Republic Tael, 1943-44, struck for French Indochina with a small deer head design, kmX3, used to pay Chinese soldiers on the Burma front, NGC certified MS61, Est \$5000. Many world coins include a good range of US gold and silver, and well-documented World collections from India, China and Europe.

New Zealand is represented by a plush case Waitangi Proof Set, Lot 381, Est \$18,000, Proof Waitangi Crown, lot 383, Est \$10,000 and other high grade predecimal coins. Tradesmen's tokens include the rare high grade AS Wilson Dunedin Penny of 1858 in aEF, Est \$2000.

British coins offer an attractive Gothic Crown of 1847 in aEF, Est \$5500, and Charles I Crown of 1634/5, Est \$1300 in aF/F. Crowns, Halfcrowns, early hammered and gold fill out the range.

The 114 medal lots include eight 1860's New Zealand Medals. Lot 5 was awarded to John Rule of the rare unit, Auckland Naval Volunteers, Est \$4000. Eight New Zealand Memorial Cross lots honour those who gave their lives. Many British groups, with extensive service records and research, are joined by USA and Soviet groups including a prestigious Order of Lenin in Gold and Platinum to a Soviet Engineer from 1954, Est \$3000.

Particular thanks again go to all our team who have created this auction for our vendors and buyers – Liam Jennings, Michail Andreef, John Mowbray, Margaret Galt, and auction organisers Maree Malin, Kirsten Fulford, Bronwyn Mill, Jan Macdonald & Sallie Bassett.

- 1 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL PAIR, NZ Medal Imperial issue, ND, impressed 2876 PTE. J. MULREY. 43RD FOOT., MYB123, gVF; & Indian Mutiny Medal 1857-59, similar impressing, MYB121. John Mulrey served with the 43rd Foot in the Indian Mutiny at Goiwasa. He served in New Zealand from 11 Dec 1863 & in the engagements at Makatu & Te Ranga. He was discharged from the 43rd regiment on 24 March 1866. gVF \$1,200
- 2 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL, ND impressed A. PEARN TARANAKI VOL., MYB123. Alfred Pearn (1843-1912), said to be the first white child born in New Plymouth, served with the Taranaki Volunteers as a Private from March 1860 until 1866. He was under fire at Waireka (28 Mar 1860), Mahoetahi (Nov 1860), Kaitake (24 March 1864), & Manutahi & Mataitawa (Oct 1864). gVF \$1,200
- 3 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL, Imperial issue, 1863 TO 1864, impressed J.BENNETT. GUNR. R.M.A. H.M.S. ESK, MYB123, Ex Dix Noonan Webb 22 July 2016, printed research notes available. John Bennett was born in Wheel, Romford, Essex in about 1834. He enlisted with the navy in 1853, at which time he was a labourer. He transferred to the Royal Marine Artillery in 1855. He served in the Baltic Sea, 1854, China Sea 1857-58, & was present at the capture of Canton in Dec 1857, & New Zealand War, in 1863-64. He was awarded the Baltic medal, China Medal with clasp Canton 1857, & New Zealand Medal. He was discharged from the Navy at the completion of his term of service in Feb 1874. Ex brooch mount Obv, also affecting two letters B & E of BENNETT, otherwise near VF. \$1,400
- 4 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL, Imperial issue, ND, engraved in sloping capitals G. WHITE LD.G. SEAMAN, H.M.S. "HARRIER", MYB123, ex brooch mount Rev, renamed otherwise gVF. \$700
- 5 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL, ND engraved JOHN RULE NO.1 CO. AUCK NAV. VOL., MYB123, sl nick rev, rare unit with only nine issued according to BBM, late issue 1913, with removed 1861 TO 1866 dates just visible. Rule was present at Pukorokoro (Miranda Expedition), South Manukau Harbour, Waiuku, Mauku & Drury 1863 & may have been involved in the capture of the large waka Te Toki-a-Tapiri, on display in the Auckland Museum. 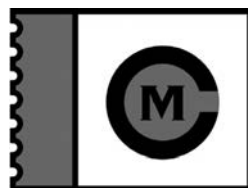

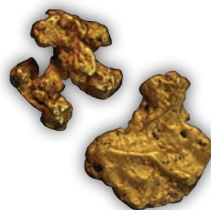
