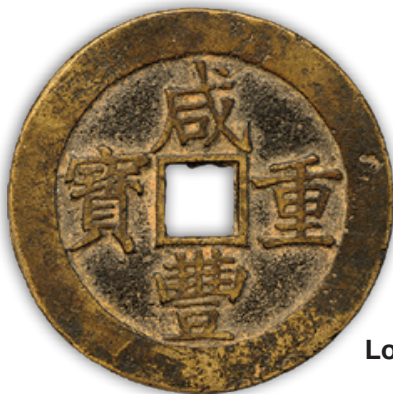

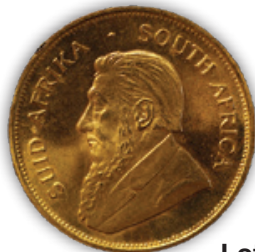

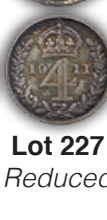

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
3. BIDDING:
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.
Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again.
The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at their discretion.
 - 3.2 Bidders shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding they have given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
 - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
 - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted on their own lots.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Absentee and online bids must comply with the following steps:

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. **Live online bidding** is available via [auctions.mowbraycollectables.com](https://www.auctions.mowbraycollectables.com) and our mobile apps. **A 3% surcharge applies for this service, whether placed prior to, or during the auction.** Bids prior to the auction may be placed through our websites, apps or directly with us.
Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within seven days of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of the auction date will be subject to a 24% p.a. penalty interest, applied to the unpaid balance on a daily basis from the auction date. Cash payments of \$10,000 or more cannot be accepted.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:
 - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
 - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
 - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and
 - 9.4 to proceed against the buyer for damages for breach of contract.

International Numismatic Auction #33

Friday 20th September 2024 - 12 noon

Mowbray Collectables 20 September 2024 auction in Wellington offers \$510,000 in estimates and 622 lots. Many rare items offer a wide choice for both collectors and bullion buyers.

With 54 Trading Bank Notes, 72 predecimal, 82 decimal and 12 error banknotes in the New Zealand category, there is extensive coverage. Of outstanding interest is the Bank of Otago Limited Five Pounds of 4th May 1868, gF, cancelled but the only one in private hands, estimated at \$10,000. A National Bank Five Pounds of 1st June 1926 in VF and Union Bank of Australia Five Pounds of 1st October 1923 in VG are scarce too. Notes of the smaller banks also include the Colonial Bank, Bank of New South Wales and Bank of Australasia.

Reserve Bank issues include an attractive Lefeaux 50 Pounds in gF, estimated at \$20,000 and two Hannah 50 Pounds in aF at \$2500 and F at \$3000. The extremely rare Wilson O/K prefix One Pound features for the first time in a Mowbray catalogue in aVF at an estimate of \$8000. Decimal issues feature a good range of same number sets (17 lots from Hardie onwards) and a wonderful range of first and last prefix notes, many with low serial numbers.

A 1935 Threepence certified by PCGS as MS66, is the best ever offered by Mowbrays (Est \$3000). Many predecimal issues are PCGS certified at MS64 or better. Another star New Zealand coin is the 1975 Twenty Cents mule, struck on a Hong Kong Two Dollar blank and certified as MS62 by PCGS, estimated at \$3500. The eight New Zealand gold coins cover the harder to find 2003 to 2016 period with Lord of the Rings, Hobbit and 2014 Māori Art issues.

World Banknotes showcase rare Chinese and Hong Kong lots including a Hong Kong & Shanghai Banking Corporation Ten Dollars, Chefoo domicile, 1st September 1922, serial 03009, PS317a, with a stunning hand signed design, PMG certified AU55 (Est \$10,000).

138 World Coins include the rare 1916/16 overdate nickel amongst the twelve US lots, discovered by Mowbrays for the lucky vendor. It has slight verdigris but is a clear EF, Est \$15,000. An outstanding offering from major Indian collections includes the rare 1939 Bombay Rupee, Est \$7500, PCGS certified AU55, another Mowbray discovery for a different vendor.

The 47 ancient coin lots are mostly higher grade in VF to EF including Rome, Parthia and Greece. They include Julius Caesar denarius, North African mint with Venus and Aeneas walking (S1402), Est \$1000, in aEF. British coins include attractive original short proof sets from 1911 to 1953 and earlier hammered coins from Aethelred II onwards.

World gold coins include a UNICEF International Year of the Child Set of 11 with 5.3 ozs of gold, (Est \$21,000) including the sought after China 450 Yuan 1979, km9, with two charming children planting a flower. Six ever-popular Krugerrands from 1975 to 1991 extend the range.

Military medals offer a good range of New Zealand WWII Memorial Crosses. Other medals include a platina Resolution and Adventure Medal with British provenance, so exportable from New Zealand, Est \$6000, and a rare New Zealand 1971 One Ton Cup 18ct gold medal, MP1971/11, one of only two minted (Est \$4500).

- 1 NZ WW2 Group (5), Memorial Cross, 1939-45 Star, Africa Star, War Medal & NZ Service Medal, also with memorial cross box, delivery envelope, named award slip, & copied service records, to 32472 PTE. W. S. CLYMA. Wilfred Sydney Clyma was born in Dunedin on 28 Sept 1911. He enlisted with the 25th Bn on 21 March 1940 & embarked for service overseas on 27 Aug 1940. He was killed in action on 1 Dec 1941 in the Western Desert. AU \$600

- 2 NZ MEMORIAL CROSS to 29860 PTE. F. J. ANTUNOVICH. Francis (Frank) Joseph Antunovich was born in Whangarei in 1912. His father migrated from Dalmatia & was naturalised in New Zealand in 1904. Frank worked as a labourer prior to enlisting. He enlisted in the 18th Bn on 18 July 1940, embarked overseas on 19 Dec 1940 & was killed in action on 25 May 1941. He is buried in the Suda Bay War Cemetery, Crete. He also received the 1939-45 Star, Africa Star, War Medal & NZ War service medals; with service records & case. EF \$400

- 3 NZ MEMORIAL CROSS to 594302 PTE. S. M. BARTLETT. Sydney Marne Bartlett was born in 1914. Prior to enlisting he was a quarry worker in the Mt Somers Lime works & a volunteer army bandsman for 6 years. He enlisted as a married man with a wife named Roberta, but he was not married. They had a son in 1940. He enlisted with the 23rd Bn on 14 April 1942, embarked overseas on 14 May 1943, was killed in action on 15 Feb 1944 & commemorated at the Cassino War Cemetery, Italy; with service records & case. EF \$400

- 4 NZ MEMORIAL CROSS to 24041 PTE. T. GREEN. Thomas Green was born in 1918 in Hangatiki, Waikato. His parent's names were Tawhi Te Puaha Kirini Green (1886-1953) & Teremaanu te Amohanga nee Te Hauparoa (1897-1940). He was a labourer when enlisted with the 24th Bn on 17 Jan 1940, embarked overseas on 27 Aug 1940, killed in action on 24 Nov 1941 & is buried at the Knightsbridge Cemetery, Libya. aEF \$400

- 5 NZ WWI Trio to 1680 PTE G.TAIT. R.A.M.C., incl 1914 Star with 5th Aug - 22 Nov clasp. George Tait was born in Christchurch, New Zealand in 1876, the son of Alexander McGregor & Frances Tait. When war broke out, he was a medical student in Edinburgh & enlisted with the Royal Army Medical Corps. He listed prior service with the RAMC.
