






- 1 INSPECTION: No lot is available for inspection by post.
- 2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
- 3. BIDDING:
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.
 Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the

International Numismatic Auction #34 Friday 14th March 2025 - 12 noon

Welcome to our 34th International Numismatic Auction to be held on 14 March 2025 in Wellington. This Auction offers over \$470,000 in estimates and 587 lots. Many rare items offer a wide choice for both collectors and bullion buyers.

The Auction will start with 122 medals lots including lot 31, Est \$2,500 a scarce New Zealand Military Medal of 1944 to William Aylward who provided covering fire from a barge with a rifle grenade to protect a beach landing party, successfully silencing heavy machine gun fire. He then defended the barge against six enemy dive bombers with machine gun fire regardless of his own safety. The medals include interesting NZ Wars Medals, Memorial Crosses, Fire Service and commemorative medals.

In World coins, you will find lot 199, Est \$12,000 a rare 1931 Irish Free State Proof Set, with 1928 coins added to provide the full "Barnyard" set. The silver coins show a beautiful cameo contrast. This set was originally acquired by a senior New Zealand official involved in arranging the New Zealand predecimal coin designs and procurement in 1933. Additionally, amongst the 173 world and ancient coin lots, there are 38 Indian coin lots including lot 161, a 1939 Rupee NGC certified AU58, Est \$10,000. We also offer a specialised Canadian collection.

Shipwrecks are represented in five lots. Lot 299 is a 1857S \$20, PCGS MS63 from the "SS Central America" wreck, which foundered in a hurricane in September 1857 travelling from Panama to California, with over 300 lives lost, Est \$17,000. Another \$20 Double Eagle, lot 300, is a 1865S in MS62, Est \$15,500, salvaged from the "Brother Jonathan" which sank with over 200 lives lost on 30 July 1865 off California. The other three lots are coins from New Zealand Shipwrecks, the "Elingamite", lot 396 and "Tararua", very rare lots 397 and 398.

Gold items on offer total over \$153,000 in estimates, across 94 lots, including lot 428, the highly sought-after NZ Pukaki Proof \$10 coin of 2004, estimated at \$6,500.

The eight Fifty Pound Notes are the widest range we have ever offered. The top banknote on offer is lot 469 New Zealand issued Bank of Australasia, Fifty Pounds, of 17 April 1913, serial number 8,598, one of only three examples in private hands and very rare, graded Fine, Est \$12,000.

Of the 83 lots of Reserve Bank of New Zealand notes offered, a scarcely seen Lefeaux Fifty Pounds specimen forms part of lot 505 a set of three with Five and One Pound Specimens. Officials took no chance of someone passing these off as the real thing – they were cut diagonally and reassembled with tape, so the grades are a low "Otherwise G - F". Est \$4,000.

World Banknotes include a good Fijian selection from the 1870's to the 1940's, including George V. And of course, there are also scarcer NZ coins, including a Waitangi Crown, and scarcer tokens, including a superb Internment Camp Two Shillings, lot 377 in UNC.

George Smyth appears on the medal roll for men who served with the 58th Foot in the 1845-7 New Zealand campaign. He appears on a list of men who were wounded, published in the New Zealand Spectator & Cook's Strait Guardian, 21 Jun 1845. though it is unclear where & when he was wounded. He served with the 58th Foot for 8 years & then remained in New Zealand in the Auckland district. In 1877 he was recorded as winning the Otahuhu Agricultural Society ploughing contest & in 1896 was in Otahuhu. gVF \$1,000

2 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL 1861 TO 1866 impressed SERGT, D. RUDDOCK. 3RD, WAIKATO REGT, XXXXXd out, SPEC impressed. Daniel Rossiter Rudduck was arrested for larceny in 1853 but apparently served in Crimea with his brother who was killed there. He emigrated to New Zealand & is on the medal roll as a Sergeant with the 3rd Waikato. He settled in Oamaru & died there in 1915. AU

3 NEW ZEALAND MEDAL 1861 TO 1866, impressed A.HARRISON. Arthur Harrison was a civilian bullock driver with the Imperial Commissariat Transport Corps, with the original cardboard box of issue, as purchased by vendor in Wellington in 1981, in good condition but edges split. Handwritten naming on box is in the original style, no rank or unit named on the medal. EF
