1. **INSPECTION:** No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. **EXTENSION:** Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding \$70.
3. **BIDDING:**
 - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale.
Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again.
The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at their discretion.
 - 3.2 Bidders shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding they have given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
 - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
 - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted on their own lots.
 - 3.5 Staff and Shareholders of Mowbray Collectables may participate in this auction

6. **ESTIMATES:** Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at 70% of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. **PAYMENT:** Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 17% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 14 days of the auction date will be subject to a 24% p.a. penalty interest, applied to the unpaid balance on a daily basis from the auction date. Cash payments of \$10,000 or more cannot be accepted.

International Numismatic Auction #37

Friday 18th September 2026 - 12 noon

Our 18 September auction offers a diverse 643 lots with coins, medals and banknotes with wide appeal.

A special feature is most of the Jim Howell Penny Collection in 101 lots. It celebrates the whole story of the Penny from its ancient origins, through mediaeval times, to worldwide use, including in the magnificent art of 18th century British tokens and the huge range of penny exonomia. See more below.

Top New Zealand coin lot is a Waitangi Proof Set in deluxe case with well-matched coins, amongst the best we have offered, estimated at \$NZ18,000. Grading company lots are becoming more popular in New Zealand coins, with 46 mainly PCGS lots affording high-grade coverage of pre-decimals. Thirty further higher-grade New Zealand predecimal lots hold their own, with a top 1936 florin estimated at \$2500.

Tokens have a good outing, with 37 New Zealand & Australia token lots. The rare Wilson Dunedin penny and Internment Camp Five Shillings are each estimated at \$2000.

New Zealand banknotes star the carefully tended 1967 double specimen banknote set of Reserve Bank Governor Sir Alan Low, estimated at \$10,000, and signed by 16 Reserve Bank Board and Decimal Currency Design Committee members. All up there are 111 New Zealand banknote lots, including the only known non-cancelled Dunedin domicile Bank of Australasia fifth issue One Pound of 1 January 1906, estimated at \$5000. An original Ten-Shilling 1934 Lefeaux note, one of five presented to Reserve Bank Directors, serial Z000007 in gF, is estimated at \$5000.

The World War Two DCM and MM medal group of 10 to Captain John Alexander Redpath tells the story of two amazing POW escapes in Greece and Italy, the latter while with MI9. Estimated at \$14,000, it is one of 60 military medal lots. Gallipoli groups also feature. Other medals include scarce Canadian order and decoration specimens and a wide range of commemoratives.

The Jim Howell Penny Collection

Born in Napier, James (Jim) Howell joined the Department of External Affairs in 1962, entered the diplomatic service in 1966 and has held diplomatic assignments in Viet Nam, Thailand, Malaysia, Peru, the Netherlands, the United States and Saudi Arabia. Now semi-retired, he is senior historical adviser in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT).



Exotic coins sparked an early interest in coin collecting and philately. Another love is woodwork, pursued through to bespoke classic pieces such as the cabinets for his penny collection, now for sale, and an exact replica of a Tutankhamen throne he saw and studied in Cairo. He has a Master Woodworker award from the Wellington Guild of Woodworkers. He holds distinctions in photography, twice as NZ Photographic Society champion print winner, and archery, as 1990s NZ national men's freestyle (Olympic style) champion. His works as a writer include *I Just Wish Grandad Was Here For Me To Ask* (2023) on family history, a guide to the historical records of MFAT, and now *The Mighty Penny: Its Story So Far* (2026).

Following earlier sales of gold items, hammered pennies and New Zealand tokens in March 2026, the main part of the Jim Howell Penny collection is now offered in Lots 186 to 286 in this sale. With estimates totalling \$70,000, the collection ranges from ancient Roman denarii to Mediaeval, European and worldwide cousins of the penny, related exonumia and the full British World. Highlights include many Anglo-Saxon and British examples, such as sceattas, Maundy, patterns, British trade tokens from the 17th Century onwards and issues up to King Charles III. Outstanding exonumia includes antique money boxes, play and educational examples, trench art and more. Higher-denomination groats, shillings and more ensure the story is fully expounded.

The story of the penny is told in an accompanying detailed book, available for download on our website. Also available are two impressive display cabinets, one included as part of Lot 282 with 169 exonumia items. The other was built to hold the high-quality albums of the collection and is available by negotiation. Please contact us if interested.

The Exonomia Cabinet is a bespoke display cabinet in fine materials such as mahogany made by Jim Howell as a master craftsman, and so is a unique offering. All items are beautifully displayed in custom storage drawers designed to accommodate items of a wide variety of shapes and sizes. Measurements are H 925mm, W 700mm, D 590mm. The height measurement increases by 225mm when detachable legs are in place, for a standing height of 1150mm.

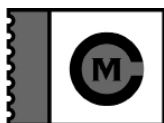

- 1 NZ DCM & MM WWII Group of 10 to John Alexander Redpath. Redpath defied the odds in two outstanding escapes from captivity, the second of which resulted from work undertaken for MI9 special operations to rescue stranded allied soldiers in 1943-44. The double decoration group of importance to both New Zealand & Great Britain collectors includes his Distinguished Conduct Medal, impressed 30836 SGT. J. A. REDPATH. 2 N.Z.E.F. 1942., Military Medal impressed 30836 S/SGT. J. A. REDPATH DCM. 2NZE 1944., NZ War Service Medal 1939-1945, Defence Medal 1939-45, War Medal 1939-45, Africa Star, 1939-45 Star, Italy Star, Greek War Medal, & 1953 silver Coronation Medal, all EF. Redpath was born in Canterbury in 1904 & died in Wellington 9/04/1969. Born into a well-known trading family, Redpath claimed to be 3 years younger than he was to secure his enlistment (No. 30836) on 11/04/1940 into the 19th Army Troops Company, 2NZE. Quickly promoted to Sergeant, he disembarked in Egypt on 30/9/1940. After the defeat of allied troops at Maleme Aerodrome, Crete, Redpath & his remaining company went to ground. Captured by the Germans, Redpath successfully coordinated & executed an escape from Galatas POW camp, evacuating to mainland Greece. Redpath's party commandeered a vessel & sailed to Alexandria, surviving strafing & bombing three times. Under Redpath's leadership, the crew made it safely to Allied-controlled North Africa. This effort & continued efforts by Redpath to rescue more stranded soldiers from Greece earned him the DCM in 1942 (439 awarded to New Zealanders during WWII). While engaging in classified MI9 operations, he was captured again by Italians & held as a POW in PG75 & 35 for 18 months, finally effecting another successful escape on 3/11/43, earning the MM. After 1856 days abroad, Captain Redpath was honourably discharged on 22/8/1946. A full hard copy biography by Graeme McLeod, extensive citations & army reports are included as well as Redpath's personal correspondence & photos. EF \$14,000
- 2 NZ DSO & DFC Group of 8 to James Bayntun Starky, DSO GVI 1943, DFC 1943, G VI, with case (both officially replaced 1989), 1939-45 Star, Air Crew Europe Star 1939-45, Africa Star 1940-43, Defence Medal 1939-45, War Medal 1939-45, Midi, & NZ War Service Medal 1939-45. Exceptionally well documented group, with ribbon bars & MID; RAF & NZ cloth insignia "wings" & identity disk; service records; award certificates for MID 11 June 1942, DSO & DFC; letter about replacement of DSO & DFC 20 March 1989 from NZ Ministry of Defence; Book by Wing Commander H P 'Sandy' Powell, *cont....*

-cont "Men With Wings", Allan Wingate, London, 1957 with chapter on Starky; two RNZAF logbooks covering August 1940 to July 1944 with military & civilian entries July 1944 to April 1990, including as a jet test pilot for Armstrong Siddeley until the mid 1950s, citations for the award of the DSO & DFC; correspondence including with Starky by recovering wounded crew members, photograph album with details of a prototype Canberra bomber which crashed with Starky as pilot in 1954, & other photographs of Starky. Starky's 1942 MID recognised his Middle East flying, including a crash landing in which two crew were killed, which he survived, then walked 12 miles while injured to seek help for crew & to locate the Wellington Bomber. The DFC recognised 42 sorties against highly defended targets, many in Germany, & returning successfully on 5/6 September after losing 6 feet of his right wing. The DSO recognised his skill & leadership in returning his seriously damaged Lancaster after losing his Navigator & Wireless Operator following a German night fighter attack. More detail is available in online medal notes. DSO & DFC AU, others gVF. \$8,000
- 3 NZ Queen's South Africa Medal 1899-1902, hand to F, clasps South Africa 1901, Transvaal, Orange Free State & Cape Colony, impressed 3804 PTE C.H. WALKER, N: ZEALAND M.R. Charles Hunter Walker from Dunedin, served in South Africa from 1901 as part of the NZ Mounted Rifles, 6th Contingent, No. 20 Company, & in WWI. gF \$300
- 4 NZ Queen's South Africa Medal 1899-1902, hand to F, clasps South Africa 1902, Transvaal, & Cape Colony, impressed 6329 Pte T. Campbell. NZ. CONTG. MYB150. Private Thomas Campbell, born 1881 Wellington 1881, lived in Karori, worked as a clerk & is listed in the 7th Contingent's mounted rifles. He sailed with the 8th Contingent in 1902 aboard HMS Surrey. Returning home, he enlisted in WWI as No. 78018. He died 16 June 1940 & is buried in Karori Cemetery. EF \$350
- 5 NZ Queen's South Africa Medal 1899-1902, hand to F, MYB150, clasps Cape Colony, South Africa 1902, Transvaal, impressed 5006 HOSP: CPL: W. H. TOOHILL. N.Z.M.R. 8TH CONT: William Henry Toohill was born 1879 in Wellington. He worked as a Chemist in Wellington, enlisted with the 8th Contingent regimental staff & departed Auckland February 1902 aboard HMS Surrey. Toohill was assigned as a vital Corporal Hospital Dispenser. He died 27/7/1936 & is buried in Whanganui's Aramoho Cemetery. gEF \$400
- 6 NZ (7), WWI & WWII Family groups (3), WWI group (4), 1914-15 Star, BWM, VM & MSM, impressed 12-200 Cpl J. A. GRAHAM. 1/AUCK:R. with pocketbook & Sergeant's chevron. James Alexander Graham was born 2/4/1891 in Waitara, enlisted into the Auckland Regiment, 15th Coy. He disembarked with the MEF at Gallipoli 5/5/15, was wounded in the shoulder during the second battle of Krithia 8/5/15 & was off strength for 3 months while recovering at Helouan hospital. Evacuated off Gallipoli, transferred to France & promoted to Corporal cont....

....cont by 1/4/17, he took leave to attend officers' school. Graham was awarded the MSM & promoted to Sergeant for valuable service in the field by 28/7/18. After 4 years 162 days, Graham was discharged 10/4/20 & died 12/10/65 in Tauranga; WWI group (3), 1914-15 Star, BWM, VM, medals impressed 11/499 TPR . J. T. GRAHAM. N.Z.E.F. & three entered paybooks. John Telfar Graham, brother of J.A Graham, was born 16/2/1894. Enlisting 18/8/14 into the Wellington Mounted Rifles 2nd Squadron, he disembarked in Alexandria 30/12/14, & was transported with the WMR to ANZAC Cove. He participated in the battle of Chunuk Bair & was shot during its defence on 16/8/15, dying in Alexandria 4 days later; & WWII group (2 items) Dog tags & entered paybook named to Alexander John Graham, son of J.A. Graham (No. 446727), born 25/8/22 in Morrinsville, joined 1/9/41 the 1st Battalion Hauraki Regiment, the core of home defence, final army pay entry 19/10/45. Copies of all service histories provided. gEF

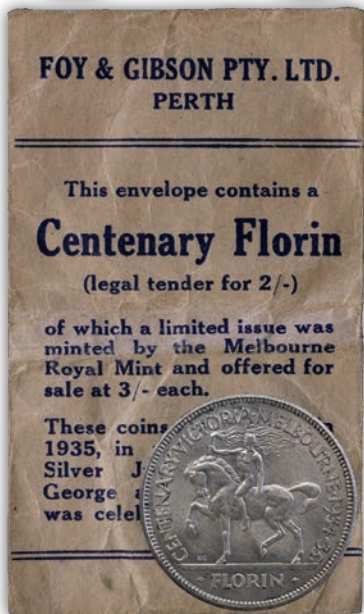

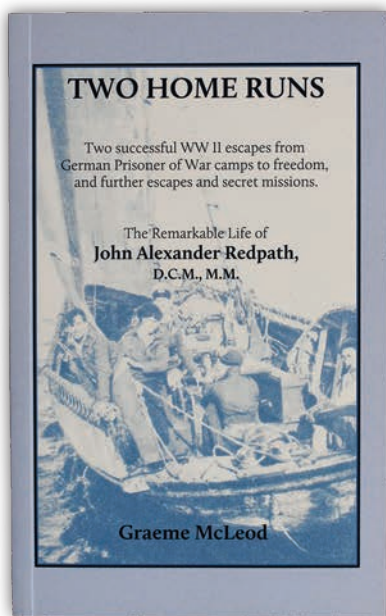
