In May 1900, a horse kicked him badly wounding him in the knee so he returned to have treatment at Dunedin hospital for 6 months. He enlisted for service in WWI with the 2nd NZ Field Artillery Brigade 6th Battery in Aug 1915, largely serving in France before falling ill in Jan 1918 & discharged in Jun 1918. VF - gVF	\$225.00
